Student Population:	Over 40,000 students from more than 150 countries
Minimum Admissions Average:	65%, but higher for certain programs.
Basic Admissions Requirements:	The minimum requirement for consideration of students from British Columbia is the Grade 12 diploma, with 4 provincially examinable Grade 12 courses. Note that students are no longer required to take the provincial examinations. Assessment is based on the school mark, even in those cases where the optional provincial exam has been written, unless the results increase the student's average. Certain programs have additional requirements.

General Scholarship Application Deadline:	Students are automatically considered for entrance scholarships upon submission of an admissions application.
Decision Criteria:	Entrance Scholarships are available to full-time students entering university studies for the first time. Candidates are selected by Faculties/Schools in co-operation with the Financial Aid and Awards Office, and in certain cases, in co-operation with academic departments as well. Selection is automatic, based on academic ranking as assigned by the University in the course of admission file processing. For some Entrance Scholarships, selection is based on submission of a portfolio and/or other specific materials. Only selected candidates are notified. Detailed description of entrance scholarships and awards, including those that require applications on the part of the candidates, are available on the Financial Aid & Awards website.

What's New at Concordia?



The new Engineering, Computer Science and Visual Arts Integrated Complex opened in September 2005. The two towers of the high-tech complex are completely integrated with links at every floor and a common corridor. The 17-storey Engineering and Computer Science tower houses research and graduate teaching labs, and administrative offices. The Visual Arts tower features state-of-the-art facilities, an art gallery, a

black box theatre, art history amphitheatres and specialized facilities for Hexagram, the Institute for Research/Creation in Media Arts and Technologies.

The John Molson School of Business will soon have a building of its own. It will include digitally equipped teaching amphitheatres and classrooms, faculty and graduate student offices, the Office of the Dean, student and faculty social space, as well as space for privatized programs. Special features also include case study rooms designed for group work, and laboratories for consumer behaviour research.
