Undergraduate Admissions/Program Information

Admissions Average:	Varies by program. Generally a 75%-80% average for early admission.
Minimum Admissions Average:	70%
Basic Admissions Requirements:	BC students: English 12 + 3 or 4 other provincially examinable courses and up to one other course from an approved list of grade 12 courses (for a total of 5 courses). Please see Discover.Dal.ca for a list of acceptable 5 th courses. Alberta students: English 30/31 or ELA 30-1 and 4 other 30 level courses. Pure Math 30 or Math 31 is required for admission to Science, Computer Science, Engineering and Applied Science. For specific program admissions information, visit Discover.Dal.ca.
Application Deadline:	June 1st for Canadian students and April 1st for International students outside the US. Applicants will be considered after the deadlines on a case-by-case basis.

Faculty/Program Areas/Schools:	Faculties: Architecture & Planning, Arts & Social Sciences, Computer Science, Dentistry, Engineering, Graduate Studies, Health Professions, Law, Management, Medicine, Science. Programs: Over 180 programs and over 3600 courses
BC Provincial Exam Policy:	Dalhousie does not require provincial exams for any courses, with the exception English 12. If a student chooses to write the exam, the highest grade of either the blended grade or the school grade will be used for admission.
Self-reported Grades & Early Admission	Students can apply online beginning on October 15th by self-reporting their grade 11 marks and providing a list of grade 12 courses. Students must follow up with an official transcript before March 15 th to be considered for scholarship. Self-reporting ends on December 31 st and usually requires an 80% average or higher. Regular early admission requires an official transcript and begins in early February.

**Residence Options/
Number of Beds:** Dalhousie offers 2700 beds in a combination of traditional and non-traditional residences. 80% of rooms are single. Visit Discover.dal.ca for more information on accommodations.

**Residence Application
Deadline:** **August 1st**
 Every new student is guaranteed a place in residence, if they complete the housing application process by the deadline. Rooms are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis so students are encouraged to get their applications in early to improve their chances of getting their first choice.

Can You Apply Online? Applications are available online after students are admitted and pay a \$200 admissions deposit. The application can be found by logging into dalonline.dal.ca. The application fee for residence is \$50.

Room Deposit Fee: A \$500 residence deposit is due two weeks after confirmation is received from the housing office.

Number of Scholarships Available: Dalhousie awards over \$4 million in scholarships each year. Renewable scholarships range from \$16,000 (\$4,000/year) to the \$32,000 (\$8,000/year) Chancellors Scholarships.
