If you elect to write an optional BC Provincial Exam, the admission office will incorporate the results only if they increase your admission average.</p>
<b>Early Admissions Average:</b>	80% based on the grade 11 equivalents of the above
<b>Minimum Admissions Average:</b>	70% on four courses

<b>Number of Scholarships Available:</b>	Not fixed; upwards of two-thirds of incoming class receives a scholarship. Entrance Scholarships range from \$500-\$5,000 a year (*renewable). Other scholarships include the Bell Scholarship (6 per year valued at \$12,000 and 5 per year valued at \$9,000), and the Confederation Scholarship (12 per year valued at \$6,720)

<b>Bursary Deadline:</b>	<b>March 1</b>
<b>Decision Criteria:</b>	Academic achievement; extra-curricular involvement; personal achievement; evidence of leadership; references
<b>Guaranteed Scholarship Program:</b>	80%+ = \$500/year; 85%+ = \$1000/year; 90%+ = \$1500/year; Up to \$5000 a year (* renewable)
